

# Washington's New Electronic Product Recycling Program

As of January 1, 2009

## What Is The Electronic Product Recycling Program?

As of January 1, 2009, a new state law (The Electronic Product Recycling Act, passed in 2006) will be in effect, requiring electronic manufacturers to provide recycling services for certain electronics at no cost throughout Washington State.

The program, entitled E-Cycle Washington, is funded entirely by electronics manufacturers.

The Washington Materials Management & Financing Authority (WMMFA) is the manufacturer agency charged with establishing and overseeing the statewide program and collector network.

## What Items Are Accepted?

- **Televisions** (any make/model)
- **Desktop computers** (processing unit/tower/hard drive)
- **Laptop computers** (notebooks or portable computers)
- **Monitors** (CRT, LCD & Plasma)

*Peripheral items such as keyboards, mice, printers, fax machines and speakers are not included.*

## Who Can Use This Program?

- **Households** are defined as "Residents of Washington State"
- **Small businesses** are defined as "Businesses in Washington State with fewer than 50 employees"
- **Small governments** are defined as "a government agency for a city in Washington State with a population less than 50,000, or a county in Washington State with a population less than 125,000"
- **Non-profit and charitable organizations** are defined as "Non-profit and charitable organizations in Washington State that qualify for a taxation exemption under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986"
- **School districts**
